8. Why does the existence of many bogus miracle claims not call into question legitimate miracles occurring?
9. How might you respond to someone who objects that miracle claims by people of other religions renders Christian claims incredible?
10. What was the most helpful thing you learned in this lesson, or was perhaps particularly new or interesting to you?
