6. What does it mean to sanctify Christ as Lord in our hearts?
7. What are two characteristics that our demeanor should reflect as we seek to provide people with answers to their questions?
8. What are some of the things we can do to ensure that our lives reflect the lordship of Christ as we share Christ with others?
9. What was the most helpful thing you learned in this lesson, or was perhaps particularly new or interesting to you?
