7. How do New Agers often misunderstand the concept of Christ in relationship to Jesus?
8. How would you answer the claim that Jesus' teachings were really Eastern or pantheistic in their meanings?
9. What are the three categories of miracles Jesus performed, and what do they each demonstrate about his authority?
